Non-Profit Booth Fee \$65- Must provide non-profit paperwork with the application.

Set-up/Take-down: Set-up will start April 27th, 2024, at 7 am (early setup is not allowed). You must be set up, and all vehicles must leave the festival area by 9:00 am. After the festival ends, all areas must be cleared and vehicles moved by 5:00 pm. You will be required to stay open at all hours of the festival.

NO RAIN DATE. NO REFUNDS IN CASE OF RAIN. FESTIVAL SPONSOR IS NOT RESPONSIBLE FOR ACCIDENTS, DAMAGES, OR OTHER LOSSES INCURRED BY THE EXHIBITOR. RAFFLES ARE NOT PERMITTED.

- 2) A current photo of your booth or trailer with your name on the photo (photos will be kept on file).
- 3) Mitchell County Health Department application
- 4) A Certification of Liability Insurance coverage with Spruce Pine Main Street and the Town of Spruce Pine is listed as additional insured.
